PLANNING ON UPDATING YOUR WINDOWS AND DOORS? LOOKING TO EXTEND YOUR PROPERTY?

Please remember that you need to seek covenant approval from the Parish Council BEFORE carrying out any works. There is no charge to apply. Please send details of your proposal to the Clerk and it will be discussed at the next available Parish Council Meeting.

DUMPING GARDEN WASTE IN THE WOODLAND OR ON PARISH LAND

There have been a number of incidents where garden waste (and general waste in some cases) have been dumped on Parish Land, including the woodland areas. Clearing this up takes time and also takes resources away from other jobs that need doing. If you witness any dumping or are aware of who may be doing this – please contact the Clerk – all communications will be treated confidentially.

TREE SURGERY IN VIGO

The Autumn / Winter period is the time when our Contractors, Paul & Steph do the majority of tree surgery in the village.

We have a list of tree works which is made up of routine maintenance, work that we have identified, and work that has been identified as a result of residents contacting us.

If you have any concerns about trees, please contact the Clerk. An assessment will be made, and if work is required it will be programmed accordingly. All work is agreed by Full Council. Paul & Steph are not able to agree to any work unless it is under the direction of the Parish Council.

Under no circumstances should residents carry out work on Parish trees. Trees in Vigo are protected by Tree Preservation Orders.

VPC do have a woodland management policy which clearly states what our commitment to tree work is – this can be viewed on our website www.vigo-kent.org (click on "The Council" and then on "Procedures & Policies"). If you would like a hard copy of these documents, please contact the Clerk.

COMMUNITY WARDEN CONSULTATION

Are you in favour of Vigo Parish Council sponsoring a Community Warden for one day a week in Vigo (average cost per household £12.44 per year)?

THE RESULTS:

Vigo Parish Council were pleased to receive a great response to the Community Warden consultation that was sent out recently. We received a fantastic 14% response rate by elector (212 responses from a total electorate of 1,514). There was a 20% response rate by household (164 responses from a total of 798 properties). The vote split was very clear with a resounding **75% of people voting YES**, and 25% voting NO.

WHAT HAPPENS NOW?

The Parish Council met on 12th December to discuss the results, with a unanimous decision made to budget £9,000 to sponsor a Warden for one day a week in Vigo, from April 2025. Vigo Parish Council will now write to Kent County Council to inform them that they wish to move ahead with the proposal. We will do what we can to secure the services of Mandy Cason, who had (up until now) been the Warden in Vigo for over 20 years.

Thank you to everyone who took the time to reply. We would also like to thank all those who added comments, both positive and negative, which we have taken note of.

Our byword is 'more than a just a foodbank'. We offer a helping hand to anyone who walks through our doors. We do not require paperwork and that way we offer a non-judgmental service that can respond quickly to a need. Each foodbank opens different days and times, and these are displayed on the web-site. Should you wish, you would be welcome to bring your


personal donation to the foodbank and someone will receive you and offer a hot drink and explain how we operate.
