

Vacancy for a PARISH COUNCILLOR

Help shape village life and be the voice of local residents



Following the resignation of two Councillors, and no call for an election, Vigo Parish Council has **TWO vacancies** which can now be filled by co-option.

About the role:

- The role of Councillor is varied and involves contributing to decisions and issues affecting local residents.
- The Council works as a team to represent residents, set priorities and budgets, and deliver projects to enhance village life.
- The role is unpaid, and typically involves one meeting a month, plus other occasional working party groups. Approximately 5 – 7 hours a month.

Who are we looking for?

- Someone who cares about Vigo
- No previous experience needed, just your enthusiasm, integrity, and time

Eligibility: who can apply?

- You must meet at least **ONE** of the following criteria:
 - be an elector of Vigo Parish
 - have resided in the Parish for the last 12 months
 - had your principal or only place of work in the Parish for the last 12 months
 - have lived within three miles of the Parish for the last 12 months.

How to apply:

- Please email an expression of interest to clerk@vigo-pc.gov.uk outlining:
 - Your connection to Vigo
 - Any skills, knowledge or interest you can bring
 - Confirmation that you meet the eligibility criteria
- Applications are to be received by **Monday 13th October 2025**.
